Information obligations according to Articles 13 and 14 GDPR

According to Articles 13 and 14 EU GDPR, the controller must provide the information specified in the articles to a data subject whose data he processes. This information sheet complies with this information requirement.

1. Names and contact details of the person responsible and, if applicable, their representatives:

2. The association's board of directors is responsible for carrying out the tasks and obligations in accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation and the Federal Data Protection Act.

3. Purposes for which personal data are processed:

The personal data is processed for the implementation of the membership relationship (e.g. invitations to meetings, collection of contributions, organization of sports activities).

Furthermore, personal data will be forwarded to the regional associations for participation in competitions, tournaments and games.

In addition, personal data in connection with sporting events, including reporting on them, is published on the club's website, in the club's appearances on social media and on the websites of the professional associations and transmitted to local, regional and national print media.

4. Legal basis on which the processing takes place:

Personal data is generally processed because it is necessary to fulfill a contract in accordance with Article 6 Paragraph 1 Letter b) GDPR. The contractual relationships primarily concern the membership relationship in the club and participation in the games of the professional associations.

If personal data is collected without the processing being necessary to fulfill the contract, the processing takes place on the basis of consent in accordance with Article 6 Paragraph 1 Letter a) in conjunction with Article 7 GDPR.

The publication of personal data on the Internet or in local, regional or national print media is carried out to protect the legitimate interests of the association (see Article 6 Paragraph 1 Letter f) GDPR). The association's legitimate interest is to inform the public by reporting on the association's activities. In this context, personal data including pictures of participants are published, for example as part of reporting on the club's sporting events.

5. The recipients or categories of recipients of the personal data:

Personal data of members who take part in the games and competitions of the state associations will be passed on to the respective state association in order to acquire a license, a scoring card, a player pass or other right to participate.

The members' bank details will be forwarded to Volksbank Düsseldorf-Neuss eG for the purpose of collecting contributions.

6. The duration for which the personal data will be stored or, if this is not possible, the criteria for determining the duration:

The personal data is stored for the duration of the membership.

When membership ends, the data categories will be retained for a further ten years in accordance with the statutory retention periods and then deleted. In the period between termination of membership and deletion, the processing of this data is restricted.

Certain categories of data are stored in the club archive for the purpose of the club's chronicle. These are the categories first name, last name, membership of a team, special sporting successes or events in which the person concerned was involved. The storage is based on the club's legitimate interest in the historical documentation of sporting events and successes and the respective composition of the teams.

7. The data subject is entitled to the following rights under the conditions set out in the articles:

- the right to information under Article 15 GDPR, -
the right to rectification under Article 16 GDPR, - the
right to deletion under Article 17 GDPR, - the right
to restriction of processing under Article 18 GDPR, - the right to data
portability under Article 20 GDPR, - the right to object in
accordance with Article 21 of the GDPR, - the right
to complain to a supervisory authority in accordance with Article 77 of the GDPR, -
the right to be able to revoke a given consent at any time, without this affecting the lawfulness of the processing carried out based on the
consent before its revocation .

8. The source from which the personal data comes:

Personal data is generally collected as part of purchasing membership.
